- Consider Impact factor in submitting journal



What we have learnt (2)

- Follow the conventions (abstract, background, objective, methodology, results and discussion)
- Edit your paper will save time (highly recommended)
- Findout a knowledgeable reviwer
- Use relevant and enough number of references
- Mixing results and discussion



What we have learnt (3)

- Using mind mapping to develop structure of paper
- Learning as a reviewer is worthwhile
- Aware of grammatical problems (article, preposition, conjunction, wordiness)
